

FAQs

1. When does the application start and end?

Ans: It starts on the 24th June and ends on the 9th August 2024.

2. Who is eligible to apply?

Ans: Women aged 18-55yrs old who are;

- a. Resident in Nigeria,
- b. Own and manage their own business in Nigeria
- c. Access Bank account holders (Individual or Business accounts)
- d. With businesses registered with the Corporate Affairs Commission
- 3. Can joint business apply?

Ans: Yes, joint businesses can apply if

- i. a woman owns at least 50% of the business
- ii. manages the business
- iii. if selected, she will attend the mini MBA series
- iv. if the business is jointly owned by women one of the women will attend the Mini MBA
- 4. How can I apply?

5. How will I know if my application has been selected?

Ans: Please check your dashboard at the end of the application period. You will also be contacted by the Access Bank team via an email.

6. What are the prizes to be won?

Ans: There are two categories prizes to be won

- 7. What is the application process?

Ans:

Stage 2: Your business in 60 seconds

- Create a 60-second video with clear audio about your business using a video camera or a quality phone.
- Click the upload button afterwards to upload your pitch video. The video should not be more than 50MB in size.

Stage 3: Top 120 entries will be contacted via email to proceed with the mini MBA program.

8. Where is the mini MBA training taking place?

Ans: The training will take place physically in Lekki, Lagos

9. Who cannot apply?

- a. Not for profit organizations/NGOs
- b. Employees, contractors, officers, directors or agent of any of the following: Access Bank Plc, or any parent, subsidiary, affiliated or related entity
